Registering iPod touch

Before you can use any of the iPod touch features, you must use iTunes to set up iPod touch. You can also register iPod touch and create an iTunes Store account (not available in some countries) if you don't already have one.

Register iPod touch:

- 1 Download and install the latest version of iTunes from www.itunes.com/download.
- 2 Connect iPod touch to a USB 2.0 port on your Mac or PC using the cable that came with iPod touch.
- 3 Follow the onscreen instructions in iTunes to register iPod touch and sync iPod touch with music, video, and other content from your iTunes library, and with your contacts, calendars, and bookmarks on your computer.



Syncing

About Syncing

With iPod touch, it's easy to have instant access to your music, video, downloaded applications, and other iTunes library content. iTunes can sync all this information to iPod touch, and your contacts, calendars, and your browser bookmarks as well.

iTunes lets you specify the information and content on your computer that you want to sync with iPod touch. By default, iTunes syncs automatically with iPod touch whenever you connect iPod touch to your computer.

Syncing with iTunes

You can set iTunes to sync any or all of the following:

- Music and audiobooks
- Movies
- Applications downloaded from the iTunes Store
- TV Shows
- Music videos
- Podcasts
